Rehearsal Schedule

If rehearsal times or dates change during the season, students and their guardians will be notified through both BAND and email.

Attendance Policy

Since color guard is a team sport, it is important to have the entire team at rehearsal. For absences regarding conflicts that are known in advance (family trip, extracurricular event, etc.), the Absence Request Form must be turned in ONE WEEK before the absence. This also applies to partial absences—arriving more than 30 minutes late or leaving more than 30 minutes early.

Emergencies happen of course! If there is an emergency or sickness that will affect attendance at rehearsal, please notify staff as soon as possible. If emergency absences become common, staff may need to meet with student and parents to help prevent more absences in the future.

After an absence, the student will have ONE WEEK to complete and turn in the Absence Make Up Form. This is to promote accountability and ensure that the student is caught up on anything they may have missed while absent.

Competition days are full day events. Since we have two teams, their performance times are many hours apart. We will travel to our show sites in the morning, and our bus will not return to high school until late that night. If parents of the junior team students would like to pick their student up from show sites. They must fill out and turn in the Student Release Form before the competition.

A student may NOT miss the rehearsal before a competition. If they do, they risk not being able to perform with the team at the competition.

Winter Guard is a self-funded activity. As a result, fees must cover costs for transportation, equipment, instructors, circuit membership, and other program-associated costs. All payments should be paid through Skyward or at the MRHS Main Office.

It is important for us to provide fundraising opportunities to help every student afford to participate in this sport. All fundraisers must be approved by MRHS administration. Once fundraising information is confirmed, it will be sent out to everyone to participate. If students have fundraising balances from previous seasons, they may be carried over and used towards winter guard fees.

Rehearsal Etiquette

Members of the MRHS Color Guard are expected to come to rehearsal prepared to work hard and have a positive attitude. Proper preparation involves holding the team to certain standards at rehearsal.

Come to Rehearsal Prepared

Students must come to rehearsal with all the supplies needed to have a successful rehearsal. Bring a water bottle that holds *at least* 40 oz to EVERY rehearsal. Wear appropriate rehearsal attire—comfortable clothes that you can move freely in (NO JEANS). Bring all supplies and equipment you may need for rehearsal (medications, braces, tape, snacks, etc.)

Take Care of your Body

Students MUST come to rehearsal having eaten enough food to have the physical and mental energy to have a successful rehearsal. Drink plenty of water, get plenty of sleep. Stretch your body on days that you don't have rehearsal. This is a sport, and like any sport, you must properly care for your body to be able to fully participate.

Treat Your Team and Staff with Respect

Students must not be talking or spinning while receiving instruction from a staff member. If there is conflict between members, it should be handled respectfully and involve an adult when necessary. It is not the role of members on the team to critique or correct other members.

Use Appropriate and Kind Language

Students must use appropriate language at rehearsals and when talking about their team. No swearing, bullying, gossiping, or anything of the sort will be tolerated. Students represent their team, and any negative comments about teammates or other teams is not how we represent the MRHS Color Guard program.

Be Accountable for Yourself

Students are responsible for catching up on anything they missed if they are absent from rehearsal. Varsity students are expected to stay on top of their Google Classroom assignments. Staff should be properly notified of any absences beforehand.
